



Association of Threat Assessment Professionals Distinguished Achievement Award

The Association of Threat Assessment Professionals (ATAP) established the Lifetime Achievement Award in 1998 to recognize those who have contributed a substantial body of work that has positively impacted the field of threat assessment or violence prediction. The contribution may be in the scientific, legal, organizational, or political arenas. This award has been renamed the Distinguished Achievement Award in recognition that many of the recipients will continue to provide significant contributions for many years to come.

The Distinguished Achievement Award is presented at the Annual ATAP meeting. Only one Distinguished Achievement Award will be available for the Association to award in any given calendar year.

“Nominees” for this award must have made an outstanding contribution to the development and/or understanding of threat assessment or violence prediction. In addition, their contributions should have had national or international significance. Finally, nominees will have made contributions that support the mission of ATAP. Nominees need not be members of ATAP.

Recipients of the Distinguished Achievement Award will be selected by members of the ATAP Awards Committee consisting of the ATAP President, a former award recipient, and ad hoc ATAP member or members. The identity of award recipients will remain confidential, known only to the Awards Committee until presentation at the Annual ATAP meeting.

Nominations must be received by June 10th in the year for which the nomination is made. Self-nominations are accepted.
