



## Association of Threat Assessment Professionals Meritorious Service Award

The Association of Threat Assessment Professionals (ATAP) established the Meritorious Service Award in 2004 to recognize ATAP members who have made extraordinary contributions to the mission of ATAP. Examples of such contributions may include, but are not limited to, holding a major leadership role in ATAP, successfully leading a major new ATAP initiative, or providing noteworthy leadership of an ATAP chapter.

The Meritorious Service Award is presented at the Annual ATAP meeting. Only one Meritorious Service award will be awarded in any calendar year.

Recipients of the Meritorious Service Award will be selected by members of the ATAP Awards Committee consisting of the ATAP President, a former award recipient, and ad hoc ATAP member or members. The identity of the award recipient or recipients will remain confidential only to the Awards Committee until presentation at the Annual ATAP meeting.

Nominations must be received by June 10<sup>th</sup>, in the year for which the nomination is made. Self-nominations are accepted.
